 River Creek Beginning at a Pine on S^r Pearson & Williamson line &
 runs N 28 W 40 feet to a B. O. Williamson corner then S 70 W
 57 feet to a Stake then South 60 W 15 feet to a W. Stone near
 a Long P. C. corner then South 22 E 70 feet to a Corner on
 Green line then N 69 E to the beginning containing by survey
 30 acres be the same more or less & also all woods water ways &
 waters courses & all & every the appurtenance thereunto belong
