 This indenture made this 17 day of March 1836 between James Squires Wm Hodgers
 both of the County of Jacksonburg with intent that for & in consideration of the sum
 of 60 Dollars to me in hand paid by the sd James Squires & in consideration of
 Court hereinafter mentioned & the sd James Squires have bargained & sold unto
 the sd Wm Hodgers his heirs & assigns the following property viz a gray mare 3
 called 10 head of hogs all my house hold furniture in trust for the follow
 ing fixes to it I the sd James Squires having bin indebted to the sd Wm Hodgers
 the above sum of 60 Dollars now if I the sd James Squires do not pay the sd
 Hodgers the sum of 60 Dollars on or against the 1 day of November then &
 that I the sd Wm Hodgers shall after advertising the sd property 10
 days in three publick places sell for the ready money & pay the sd
 of 60 Dollars & the balance if any to pay me my heirs or assigns
 in witness whereof I set my hand & seal the date above written
