Know ye that we for & in consideration of the sum of fifty shillings for every hundred acres hereby granted paid into our treasury by Samuel Willsons have given & granted & by these presents do give & grant unto the s<sup>t</sup> Samuel Willsons a tract of land containing thirty acres lying & being in our county of Rock-hill on the waters of M<sup>r</sup> Swells creek beginning at a B. O. a corner to Martin Shells land thence running with his line S<sup>o</sup> 87<sup>o</sup> W<sup>o</sup> 34 poles to a small red oak near Adam Ducks corner red oak thence with his line N<sup>o</sup> 79<sup>o</sup> W<sup>o</sup> 49 poles to a small red oak sapling near Ducks other corner on Adams Shells line thence with Shells line being a small spring branch N<sup>o</sup> 23<sup>o</sup> E<sup>o</sup> 64 poles to a post near corner of an s<sup>t</sup> Shells first line being 4 poles from his s<sup>t</sup> corner post oak & then with his s<sup>t</sup> first line S<sup>o</sup> 20<sup>o</sup> E<sup>o</sup> 55 poles to the beginning — Entered the 23<sup>d</sup> of July 1796

Know ye that we for & in consideration of the sum of fifty shillings for every hundred acres hereby granted paid into our treasury by John Thross have given & granted & by these presents do give & grant unto the s<sup>t</sup> John Thross a tract of land containing fifty acres lying & being in our county of Rock-hill on Catawba Waters beginning at a post oak on his old s<sup>t</sup> corner to Francis Bailey thence running with his s<sup>t</sup> line S<sup>o</sup> 56<sup>o</sup> E<sup>o</sup> 112 poles to a stake on Mary<sup>r</sup> Willsons line passing s<sup>t</sup> Thross corner B. York at s<sup>t</sup> thence with s<sup>t</sup> Willsons line S<sup>o</sup> 64<sup>o</sup> W<sup>o</sup> 34 poles to his corner B. O. thence with his other line N<sup>o</sup> 07<sup>o</sup> W<sup>o</sup> 50 poles to his other corner B. O. & B. York thence with his other line S<sup>o</sup> 04<sup>o</sup> poles to his other corner B. York thence with s<sup>t</sup> marked line N<sup>o</sup> 59<sup>o</sup> E<sup>o</sup> 55 poles to his corner B. O. & then with his other line N<sup>o</sup> 76<sup>o</sup> W<sup>o</sup> 126 poles to the beginning — Entered 25<sup>th</sup> of July 1796
